



Policy Statement Vacant MOHLTC funded residency positions

From time to time, MOHLTC funded residency positions become vacant due to the transfer, resignation or dismissal of a resident.

Program Directors are given a period of 3 months, from the time the position is vacant, to fill the position with an admissible resident at the same level of training or higher as the vacant position. Admissible residents are either Canadian medical graduates (CMG) or International Medical Graduates (IMG) with Canadian citizenship or permanent resident status, currently registered in a postgraduate residency program in Canada or the USA.

If a position is not filled within the 3 month period, it is released to the Associate Dean of Postgraduate Medical Education; the position may then be filled at the discretion of the Associate Dean to accommodate transfer requests in any of the accredited residency programs.
