

APPOINTMENT OF NEW PROGRAM DIRECTORS

1. A Program Director is to be appointed for each program.
2. The Program Director normally will not be the Department or Division Head.
3. A Program Director will be proposed by the University Department/Division Head, then ratified by consultation with the Assistant Dean of Postgraduate Medical Education (PGME). Chief Executive Officers of our teaching hospitals will receive notification of appointments of new Program Directors.
4. The office of the Assistant Dean (PGME) will advise the Royal College or College of Family Physicians of the names of appointed Program Directors.
5. A Program Director will be appointed to serve a term of up to five years. This term may be renewed for an additional period of five years.
6. At the request of the office of the Assistant Dean (PGME), in consultation with the Head of the University Department or Division, a Program Director may be replaced.
