

RESIDENT TRANSFER AD HOC COMMITTEE

PRIORITISATION CRITERIA

Transfer requests will only be considered if it is clear that the resident is not trying to circumvent the CaRMS match. Such requests will be refused.

Prioritisation Criteria for transfer between programs:

1. Medical condition (*as documented by treating physician; must include a clear comment that the resident cannot practice in the current discipline due to the medical condition*)
2. Lack of compatibility in specialty (*must be related to lifestyle or wrong career choice*):
 - resident will be required to have completed a minimum of one rotation in the discipline currently registered in
 - written evaluation of the rotation must be provided
 - must have a strong academic performance

Priorization Criteria for transfer between schools:

1. Program issues : changes made to the program from time of match (*ex: key faculty departure or accreditation status issues*)
2. Compassionate / family related issue
